Laney College Career Technical Education department and the Alameda County WIB are piloting an Introduction to Manufacturing training program.

This is a one-semester program (4 days a week, 24 hours /week) to:

- 1) Help prepare youth (ages 18 - 24) for entry-level jobs in manufacturing, and
- 2) Introduce them to the opportunities for further education in the skilled trades and other manufacturing-related careers.

The training will be general to the manufacturing industry, includes hands-on training, and incorporates a course on food sanitation that will be useful for jobs in industrial food manufacturing.

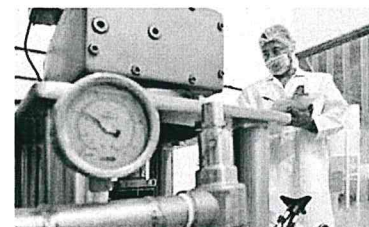
Students who successfully complete the program will receive college credit and certificates in:

- OSHA 10 Safety training
- National Career Readiness Certificate (NCRC)
- Food Handler's Certificate

Support services will include some limited transportation assistance (via vouchers), case management assistance, as well as help with job placement – although a job is not guaranteed. There are no costs to the students for tuition, books or educational fees.

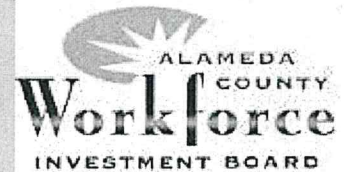
